Keeping You Informed

River Calder Wall Vegetation Clearance

As part of the continued preparation work for the Stubbing Holme Road Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), our suppliers need to undertake an engineering inspection to the walls along the River Calder to fully understand their structural condition. This will help identify the optimum design solution for the required flood wall.

We will shortly be undertaking some vegetation clearance work to these walls to help enable this inspection.

What will the work involve?

Our operational team will be undertaking vegetation clearance in the area shown on the map above. They will be using hedge cutters to cut back the vegetation.

The vegetation will then be removed from the channel. The work will be undertaken during week commencing 28th August and will take around one day.

The red line shown on the map above is the location where the vegetation will be removed along the walls of the River Calder. The area shown in blue will be where our operations team will access the river and park their vehicles.
