Hebden Bridge Flood Alleviation Schemes

September 2023

The Environment Agency is working with Calderdale Council to design and build a Flood Alleviation Scheme for Hebden Bridge.

Hebden Bridge FAS – Ecological Surveys

To assist with the design and future construction of the Hebden Bridge Flood Alleviation Scheme, our consultant BAM Nuttall Mott MacDonald Joint Venture (BMMJV), will shortly be carrying out a series of environmental surveys across the town centre at locations along Hebden Water and the River Calder. Details on the surveys and when they are likely to occur are as follows:

Ecological Walkovers – occurring on several dates throughout September & October, our terrestrial ecologists will be undertaking species surveys (i.e, Bird, Otter, Bat etc) to ensure a robust baseline is gathered.

Arboricultural Survey at Calder Holmes Park – in Autumn, our Arboriculturalist will be visiting Calder Holmes Park to assess the trees within the park (e.g. condition and type).

MoRPh survey – In September our aquatic ecologists will be visiting weirs around Hebden to understand the local river channel function.

Archaeological Watching Briefs – Throughout September and October, our Heritage Consultants will be on site supervising Trail Hole surveys around the Old Gate, Bridge Gate and Old Pack Horse bridge area.
